Visual Arts is one of the greatest visual treasures for the Deaf so encourage your Deaf artists to visually explore the riches of the visual arts. Have them discover the magic of arts and share their dreams!

Eligibility

Deaf and hard of hearing students in grades Pre-K through 12th are eligible to enter the competition in the 8th annual CAL-ED Deaf Visual Arts Gallery. All work must be original and completed during the current school year.

Categories

Each entry will be assigned to one of the following three categories and judged against other pieces within that category:

Literature: poetry, prose, or short story

Photography: prints up to 11"x14" in black & white or color

Visual Arts: drawing, painting, mosaic, printmaking, & sculptures

Entry Guidelines

- Work may not exceed 36 inches in length or width.
- All artwork must be framed.

Entry Forms

The next page of this prospectus contains entry forms. The form may be photocopied if more entry forms are needed. Please note that in addition to information on the participating student, the form also must be signed by the teacher who thereby accepts responsibility for the student's entry.

Submitting of Artwork

In order to be judged and included in the show, work must be submitted to: **Deaf Visual Arts Gallery, c/o Ms. Gena Fischer, California School for the Deaf, Riverside, 3004 Horace St., Riverside, CA 92506** by **February 13, 2009.**

No exceptions.

Judging and Awards

Judging will be based on the following criteria:

- originality
- presentation
- composition

Judges will select the best entry in each category under each age group.

Exhibit Dates

The 2009 Deaf Visual Arts Gallery will run March 13 through 15 at the Conference in San Diego. Entries must remain on exhibit throughout the show.
